PURPOSE: In order to maintain a safe working environment at any firematic incident, all personnel must have proper training in how to operate so that they may serve as an asset to the Department. To be an asset, education as to how to protect ones self from the possible hazards they may encounter as well as thorough knowledge of the command structure are of primary importance. Finally, a firefighter needs to be physically fit in order to prevent injuries from occurring while operating at an incident.

OBJECTIVE: The following minimum training must be completed and kept current in order for an individual to operate as a member of the Wyckoff Fire Department at any incident. These shall serve as minimum standards in order to be on the fireground, and further training may be required in order to qualify an individual for certain job assignments.

GUIDELINE:

Following are the minimum requirements for all personnel operating at an incident as a member of the Wyckoff (NJ) Fire Department:

1. Attend HAZCOM Training every two years.
2. Attend Blood Borne Pathogens Training every year.
3. Must have Hazardous Materials Training. Awareness and Operations. Complete initial training and then refresher hours every year. Refresher hours to be determined by Training Officer of the Wyckoff Fire Department.
4. Must attend Incident Management System Training
 - ICS-100 for all fire service personnel
 - ICS-700 for all fire service personnel
 - IMS Level 1 for all fire supervisory personnel
5. Compete Physical Exam requirement as per The Wyckoff Fire Department Respiratory Protection Program.
